Friends and Family to Remember Robert Wone on Anniversary of Murder

Robert Wone was stabbed to death on the night of August 2, 2006 while visiting a college friend and his roommates at their home on 1509 Swann Street, NW, east of Dupont Circle. With his murder as yet unsolved, Mr. Wone's friends and family, including his widow Kathy, will gather to discuss their views on the investigation and explain what they believe needs to be done to bring this case to resolution.

Eric Holder of Covington & Burling, which represents Kathy Wone, will be one of the speakers. A representative of the U.S. Attorney's Office also is expected to be present and address the gathering.

At the time of his death, Mr. Wone, 32, had recently joined Radio Free Asia as general counsel. Previously, he practiced law as an associate at Covington.
