GOVERNMENT'S RESPONSE TO DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR IN CAMERA REVIEW OF DOCUMENTS

The United States, by and through its attorney, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully responds to Defendants' Motion for *In Camera* Review of Documents (the "Motion"). As often occurs in discovery in criminal cases, the government, in the instant case, has made redactions to a number of documents to exclude matters that are not properly discoverable. These redactions have been few in number. Indeed, in the more than 1,600 pages of discovery the defense has selected nine redactions for additional information and review.

Notwithstanding the modest and necessary redactions made in this case, the defense requests in camera review of certain redactions. The government, having undertaken a careful review of the defense requests and the redactions, has unredacted one additional sentence that is duplicative of an earlier sentence on that same page, as can be seen in the attachments hereto. However, the government respectfully disagrees with the defense assertion that there is a need for in camera inspection of the remaining redactions and therefore opposes the defense's motion. Notwithstanding, the government is prepared to produce the unredacted copies of the documents to the Court for its in camera inspection at the Court's direction.



WHEREFORE, the United States of America, by its counsel, the United States Attorney for the District of Columbia, respectfully opposes the defense Motion for *In Camera* Review of Documents.




