On behalf of all defendants and defendants' counsel in the above-captioned case, we are writing to request that the trial, presently scheduled to begin on May 10, 2010, be moved to a larger courtroom. We understand that this request may be difficult to honor given the predetermined court schedules; however, in order to actively include all of defendants' counsel throughout the trial, a larger courtroom is necessary. Each defendant is actively represented by no less than two counsel. The government is purporting to call no less than six to ten experts. The defendants, collectively, will call no less than ten experts. The defense also plans to introduce a significant number of exhibits, many of which will require electronic equipment that will take up space well beyond the parameters of a standard courtroom. Presently, all counsel, defendants, their files and exhibits cannot fit inside a standard courtroom. The government is not opposed to this request. Thank you for your consideration of this request.
