
As a supplement to our previous expert witness disclosure for Dr. Henry Lee, we would like to note that Dr. Lee will also offer the following opinion:

Dr. Lee applied a chemical, tetramethylbenzidine, to the towel (Item 16) which enhanced the bloodstain. That enhancement confirmed his preliminary opinion that the impression on the towel is consistent with the towel being used to apply pressure to Mr. Wone's stab wounds. Dr. Lee's opinion is based on the aforementioned examination which occurred at the Henry C Lee Institute of Forensic Science on March 17, 2010 and his preliminary examination of the towel (Item 16) on January 20, 2010.
