
**GOVERNMENT'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE UNDER SEAL**



The United States respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order, pursuant to Rule 6(e) (3)(C)(i) of the Superior Court Rules of Criminal Procedure, permitting the disclosure of certain grand jury information, namely the grand jury testimony of defendants Dylan Ward and Victor Zaborsky. Although transcripts of said testimony have been disclosed previously to counsel for the defendants in this case pursuant to the government's discovery obligations, the government will make reference to said transcripts and the contents thereof in its Notice of Uncharged Conduct II, which will be filed later today. Additionally, the government requests that this motion and this Court's Order authorizing the disclosure temporarily be placed under seal.
